

By the buy, a big hit for Abercromby's

It's been a busy couple of weeks for Armadale-based Abercromby's, with the company totalling \$15.5 million worth of sales over 12 days.

The four sales were private to overseas buyers, two of whom were expatriates. The largest was a property in Kooyong Road, Toorak (pictured) — believed to be owned by building contractor Anthony Gannon — which sold for \$6 million to a buyer believed to be based in Asia.

Other sales included a property in Evans Court, Toorak, for \$2.5 million.

Robert Vickers-Willis, who along with director Tim Derham handled the sales, says he believes they are indicative of the strength of the market at the top end, particularly when it comes to private sales.

Mr Vickers-Willis wouldn't comment on the identity of the vendors or buyers.
